Welcome to Ubiquity's Master's Program in Wisdom Studies!

Ubiquity University is pioneering a unique educational vision that puts the student at the center of our learning system. You, the student, design what you need to learn. We are here to support your pathway. At every level, you are supported by mentors and coaches who work with you to ensure that you are getting exactly the kind of education you need for what you want to do in the world. Our BA, MA, MBA, EMBA, PhD and DMin programs all require certain core courses that in our judgment every student needs to take, to which the student adds the requisite number of courses of their choice to create the rest of their program.

Students may select courses either from the Ubiquity calendar, or from outside Ubiquity. This means that if there is a course you want to take that is offered through another institution, you are free to do so. That course can then be transferred into Ubiquity for credit toward your degree for a transfer fee of \$100 per credit.

For our Master's program, each prospective student must apply directly to our Dean of Graduate Studies who will contact you to discuss your aspirations and potential pathway. All masters students must supply transcripts of previous education and write an essay indicating the area of research that they wish to explore.

Each area of study will require different combinations of core courses. For example, our Wisdom School requires certain core courses specific to the Wisdom School. This will be worked out with each student as you enter our various programs.

Our Master's program is open to a spectrum of disciplines and interests. It aims to address a range of problems in almost every area of human and ecological concern. The program is dedicated to supporting you shape and co-create a new global civilization whereby the human species can learn to act as a responsible and caring part of our larger planetary eco-system.

We consider our Masters in Wisdom Studies program to be part of the "jewel in the crown" of Ubiquity University. Upon completion, you, the student, will be awarded the title "Master of Arts". This is an honor that society bestows, indicating respect for and acknowledgement of an expertise that the larger community can count on for its integrity and professionalism. Embarking on a Masters degree should not be taken lightly.

It is a challenging process, one that will require extensive time, effort, and commitment.

The Master's dissertation must demonstrate excellence at every level. It must show awareness of the history of the literature in your particular area; demonstrate careful analysis and understanding of the field in question; and, most importantly, offer an original contribution to the field. The dissertation must be scholarly and utilize extensive bibliographical data and footnotes. It should, in other words, be an impeccable work of research.

Master's program Core Course Requirements

Masters students must complete core courses offered by Ubiquity university as well as write a dissertation. The remaining courses can be taken from Ubiquity or elsewhere as specific courses related to the chosen field of study.

Required: 4 core courses

- *Dissertation Writing and Research Methods* with Dr. Gyorgyi Szabo (4 credits in-person)
- *Great Books with Dr. Jim Garrison and Dr. Gyorgyi Szabo* (3 credits on-line)
- *Wisdom at the Cutting Edge of Civilization* with Dr. Jim Garrison and others (4 credits in-person)
- *Ubiquity Chartres Academy*, meeting annually in Chartres, France (4 credits in-person)

Total: 15 credits

Please note that the *Wisdom at the Cutting Edge of Civilization* and the *Ubiquity Chartres Academy* courses could be substituted by another Ubiquity University offered course pending agreement with the Dean of Graduate Studies.

Masters in Wisdom Studies credit requirements and points system

20 credits must be completed from courses, plus 10 credits attained for the masters dissertation, totaling 30 credits.

Ubiquity works with a points system designed to reward students for all their achievements and motivate you towards excellence.

For the Masters program you can earn a maximum of 120,000 points. One credit is equivalent to 4,000 points. Points are awarded in the following way:

4 Core Courses	60,000
Remaining Course work	20,000
Dissertation	40,000

Total Tuition and Fees for the whole Program is \$6,000

This includes 30 credit fees (\$200 per credit)*, Dissertation fee, thesis submission fee, and all admin fees.

*This total for courses may fluctuate if courses are taken from outside Ubiquity as Independent Study. There is a credit transfer fee of \$100 per credit for any courses taken outside Ubiquity.

In-person courses will include logistics costs (for board and lodging for example) which are not included in the costs above.

Points can be compared to grades in the following way:

Credits are awarded if 60% or more points (a D grade) are achieved.
